

# ADAMSFIELD HILTON RESTORATION AND ACCESS STRATEGIC PLAN

This plan is designed to give a step by step approach to the rebuilding and continued access into the area of Adamsfield where the original hut called "The Adamsfield Hilton " was located which has since been destroyed by fire.

The work will be carried out by Four Wheel Drive Tasmania and its clubs and members in consultation with the Parks and Wildlife Service and other stake holders.

- Notify Parks of our intention to produce a strategic plan to rebuild the "Hilton"
- Identify and address Parks concerns regarding access into the area.
- Address issues relating to building permits, planning scheme requirements and type of construction on the existing site.
- Liaise with Parks to address the above prior to proceeding further.
- Apply for possible funding to assist the rebuilding of the "Hilton" and placing of interpretive signage in the area.
- Seek donations of building materials from relevant businesses.
- Put together a staged plan for the reconstruction of the "Hilton".  
Pre Fab offsite where possible.
- Organise clubs and members for working bee's for construction, floor, walls, roof, cladding, fitout and finish off.
- Final inspection for permits and compliance.
- Completion BBQ and media release.
